Generally, entrance examinations take place in January/February each year. The next possibility for the start of studies is the entrance exam's succeeding winter semester.

IMPORTANT!

Please check *exact dates of the entrance examination* as well as the *specifications for the portfolio* in the beginning of the study year in which the entrance exam takes place.

International applicants

Should applicants after the review of the portfolio require a visa to enter Austria for the second round of the entrance exam - given the exam takes place in Vienna - the Office of Student Affairs can issue an *invitation letter* upon request to be presented to the Austrian representative authority in the home country (embassy, consulate, etc.).

After successfully passing the entrance exam the Office of Student Affairs provides a *Decision regarding conditional approval of admission to study*, which is needed to apply for a residence permit for students at the respective Austrian representative authority in the home country.

IMPORTANT!

The processing time by the competent authority can take up to several months. Please inform yourself well in advance about the necessary steps.

/ Admission

IMPORTANT!

All necessary documents (see Study programmes/Requirements) need to be uploaded as original documents or official copies. Depending on the country in which the documents have been issued, each document needs to be legalised. This can take some time. Certifications in foreign languages have to be accompanied by German or English translations with public certifications.

Admission will take effect after the verification of all necessary documents and the payment of the required tuition fee.
