# Applied and Fine Arts programme for students from Ukraine at the University of Applied Arts Vienna (Angewandte)

## Whom do we address by this call?

This call has been created for students from Ukraine who have lost their homes due to the war against Ukraine. The Angewandte offers approx. 50 study places to allow a **continuation of studies for people who have recently studied at a Ukrainian Higher Arts Education Institution.**

In this sense, applications are possible if the prior programme in Ukraine is similar to one of the programmes we offer at the Angewandte: [www.dieangewandte.at/programmes](http://www.dieangewandte.at/programmes).

Students who have fled from Ukraine with a different nationality but with refugee status in Ukraine or in Austria can also apply.

## What opportunities do we offer?

Each of our departments created one or two additional study places with unlimited duration. These programmes will start on 3 October 2022. Students can either return to Ukraine at any point in time or choose to graduate at the Angewandte.

## What is the timeframe?

Online application: from **2 May 2022 12:00 noon until 23 May 2022 12:00 noon**

Announcement of the results: 6 June 2022

Begin of formal admission: 5 September 2022

Begin of studies: 3 October 2022

## What is required for application?

- confirmation of recent studies at a Higher Arts Education Institution in Ukraine
- identity document
  - Ukrainian passport, OR
  - refugee status (or subsidiary protection) in Ukraine, OR
  - refugee status (or subsidiary protection) in Austria after having fled Ukraine
- **one** PDF containing
  - portfolio containing examples of some prior work (links to video/audio files are possible)
  - CV including recent study programme
  - Motivation letter
  - Information on German and English language skills
  - additional information required by the department of choice (see following pages)
- certificates of prior studies (for MA programmes)

## How will the selection be made?

Applicants are required to choose one programme as their first choice. A committee formed by the heads of all artistic departments will discuss the applications and assign them to the study programme of choice or another fitting programme. In case there are more applications than study places, the selection will be made regarding the best fit between the applicants' potentials and the opportunities offered within the different study programmes.

Please put a download link in your .pdf in case you have video or audio files you would like to share with us. It is also possible to submit a website link.
		Graphics and Advertising	Short letter of application / motivation • Curriculum Vitae • Work and work samples: self-initiated, artistic and applied projects in the field of design and communication. Observations, concepts and ideas, expressed in appropriate techniques and disciplines such as typography and layout, logos, business cards, posters, magazines, drawings, printmaking, photography, painting, film, text, online work, etc. References / marks / credentials where applicable (copies only) • reasonable command of the German language (and the willingness to improve) because most of the lectures are in German.
		Fashion Design	The Fashion Department at Angewandte values portfolios which represents students' unique perspective and strong aesthetic sensibilities. Ideally, the portfolio consists of 1) all fashion-related work sorted per study year. We encourage students to include research, drawings, images of final garments/outfits as well as showcasing 3D making skills. 2) Students may choose to include artistic projects related to fashion, textile or other creative fields which they find relevant to showcase. 3) a CV German and English language skills.

Your motivation letter (max. 500 words) should present your personal expectations and ideas for the program. Please describe what you could contribute to the study field, link it to your previous work in art, academic subjects and artistic projects, and also give an idea how you would use the expertise, knowledge and skills gained after completing your studies. Your portfolio (max 5 MB) should contain academic and artistic or practical work. You should include your bachelor's project (abstract, documentation) and/or comparable major artistic and theoretical work. Please also send an idea for your master's thesis as a project draft (max 500 words), taking into account the requirements of experimental game cultures content and methodology and its possible impact on society (you are not obliged to implement the ideas presented here).

The selection of media is up to you, using concepts, sketches, photographs, film and sound material and/or computer-generated material. Required language skills are English and/or German. A zoom interview can be part of the admission process.

Content (e.g.): project ideas, visualized concepts, drawings, photographs, videos, documentation of three-dimensional works, documentation of performances, etc. Language skills: German or English.
